SEMI-PUBLIC TELEPHONE SERVICE

1. GENERAL

Semi-public telephone service may, at the discretion of the Company, be furnished as main telephone service where: **C**

A. There is a combination of public and customer use.

B. There is collective use of the service by guests, members or similar occupants of the premises.

2. SERVICE AND EQUIPMENT

A. Semi-public telephones are equipped with coin collecting devices or card readers, and service is normally furnished on an individual line basis only within an exchange.

B. Booths and stands may be furnished on a special assembly basis as stated in Item 2102 of the Company's General Tariff. **C**

C. Semi-public telephones are listed in telephone directories in accordance with regulations stated in Tariff Item 1600 of the Company's General Tariff. **C**

3. RATES AND CHARGES

A. Local Calls

Message Charge
per Call

Originating at semi-public telephones:

- Paid for by cash, or with an authorized prepaid cash card, via an automated card reader

\$0.50 (Note) **C**

Note:

Upon customer request, a local call also may be (1) charged on a collect, or third party billed basis, (2) billed to a commercial credit card accepted by the Company, via an automated card-reader, (3) billed as an automated calling card call or (4) billed as an operator-assisted calling card call. The rate consists of the message charge per call plus the applicable message toll transaction charge.

B. Toll Calls

Message toll calls are furnished at the applicable message toll rates and charges. Calls paid for with an authorized prepaid cash card are subject to the Automated Calling Card transaction charge.

C. Premium exchange service charges as stated in Item 720 apply when service is located outside the local base rate or island base rate area.

D. Business service charges as stated in Item 510 apply except when a move or change is originated by the Company.

E. Monthly business exchange rates as stated in Item 475 for a service location in a non-forborne exchange or the rates that are in effect in a forborne exchange location apply to all semi-public telephones.
